



Eastlea Year 2 COVID update

Dear Parents / Carers,

As outlined in our Covid protocols, unfortunately, I need to let you know that this afternoon we have been advised of a POSITIVE COVID-19 case within the Year 2 class. All the correct testing procedures have been followed. The case was asymptomatic and was found following a regular lateral flow test which has since been confirmed via a PCR.

National guidance states that close contacts of COVID-19 cases including children age 5+ should take an LFD test every day for seven days and, if negative, can continue to attend school as normal. If Covid symptoms emerge, however mild, then a PCR test should still be sought.

So, we would ask that your child takes a lateral flow test before they come to school in the morning each day for the coming week. If there are problems with sourcing a test, then please let Miss Betham know in the first instance.

If your child is unwell, or there is a positive case identified in your household, then we continue to recommend that you ring school to alert us and strongly consider keeping your child off school as a precaution to protect other pupils and staff in the class.
