

The Eastlea Summer Fayre



The time has come to confirm the details and plans for our annual summer fayre, which as you know will take place on **Friday 6th July 2018 from 2.00 – 3.30pm.** This year our fayre is going to have a 'Football World Cup theme! The 6th July will be a **non-uniform day** for the children **(£1 fine for each child** which will form part of the summer fayre profits!). Pupils and staff will be invited to come into school wearing clothing with a **football/world cup** theme – we hope this provides plenty of options for everyone – football kit, flags/national colours, sporting gear in general etc!!!!
