<p>Specialist Support and Programme Management</p>	<p>- Management and administration of the School Sport Partnership Coordinator, supported by administration and finance staff, to coordinate and run the Sport Premium programme on behalf of the 7 primary schools</p> <p>-12 x ½ days support per school provided by SSP Coordinator This time can be used to address the school's own priorities. These could include: curriculum development, subject leadership, planning, targeting particular groups of pupils in PE lessons (eg G&T, SEN, less active), supporting new teachers, preparation for Schools Games events, intra-school competition, organising "School Games Day", training and supporting Sports Leaders, etc</p> <p>-Primary Membership of Youth Sport Trust National updates on PE, sport, health and education policy, full access to YST member website and online resource library, CPD, access to "Youth Sport Trust Quality Mark" kitemark, discounts on various YST products and services</p> <p>-½ day meeting for completing School Games Kitemark Applications with ½ day supply</p>
<p>CPD</p>	<p>-Programme of CPD through Youth Sport Trust membership, including Subject Leadership course for PE Coordinator (2 full days). 1 or 2 places will be offered to schools at YST training. There will be 4 full days supply available for attending curriculum time CPD opportunities.</p> <p>-Programme of after-school "workshops" Sport specific CPD to help any staff who are interested, to prepare for School Games competitions, or develop skills and expertise for curriculum PE or extra-curricular clubs. Places are generally unlimited and are available to any interested members of staff.</p> <p>-Curriculum-time Coaching Teachers work alongside high quality coaches in PE lessons to raise confidence and competence. Eg Newcastle United Foundation for Y1/2, FA Skills coaching for any year group(s), Cramlington Rockets Tag Rugby for Y3/4 and Y5/6, Newcastle Eagles Basketball for Y5.</p>

Competition	<p>-Payment into School Games Access to full programme of Level 2 inter-school competition for KS2 pupils with progression on to Level 3 Northumberland School Games event</p> <p>-All transport to School Games events (both in curriculum time and after school). This transport will be booked by the Sport Partnership and will usually be shared with other schools.</p> <p>-Supply cover for 2 x School Games events (small primary school) or 4 x School Games events (large primary school). To attend School Games events in curriculum time.</p> <p>-At least 1 x whole-year group festival per year group, including transport</p>
Extra-Curricular Opportunities	<p>-Small Primary School: 9 x half term before school/lunchtime/after school clubs per year -Large Primary School: 12 x half term before school/lunchtime/after school clubs per year To support delivery of extra-curricular activities to increase participation and to increase the range of activities on offer to engage a wider range of pupils in extra-curricular sport.</p>
Healthy Lifestyles	<p>-Y5 Skipping In-school skipping workshop for all Y5 pupils and competition (including transport) for Y5 skipping team</p> <p>-Hula Hooping In-school “Experience day” for all pupils in R-Y3, Festival for all Y3 pupils (including transport), CPD to enable staff to run an extra-curricular club, class set of quality hula hoops for the school to keep</p> <p>-Hoops 4 Health In-school basketball coaching for all Y5 pupils, competition (including transport) for Y5 team(s), bi-annual “Healthy Lifestyle Roadshow” delivered by Newcastle Eagles players and staff.</p>
Leadership	<p>Sports Leader training, leadership opportunities at Partnership events and in-school leadership award scheme with rewards for leaders</p>
Support for most and less able pupils	<p>-Subsidised “Top-Up Swimming” programme during school holidays for KS2 pupils unable to swim</p> <p>-G&T Multiskills Academy for Y5/6</p> <p>-G&T Arts Award Programme (focus on dance) for Y4</p>
