



Eastlea Primary : Pupil premium – planned expenditure 2016-17

Budget income for pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium (86) is based on the latest figures available for the school year 2016-17.

Pupil premium provides £1300 per eligible pupil, except for those designated as LAC where £1500 is provided. This means a total of **£112,000**.
