

## Cycle Tour of Britain - Key Stage 2 (Years 3,4,5 and 6)

As you may have seen from the local/national media, the Cycle Tour of Britain which starts in Scotland, is due to pass through our region on **Monday 9**<sup>th</sup> **September**. We are fortunate that the cyclists taking part in the UK's biggest professional cycle race will pass through Cramlington on Monday afternoon for stage 3 of the 8 day event.

We are very pleased to say that our Key Stage 2 pupils have been invited to take part in this event and will have the opportunity to see the cyclists as they come through Cramlington, with a designated 'Safe Place to Stand.'

The plans and outline timings for Monday are shown below (\*clearly times for the actual event are approximate):

- 1.30 leave school and walk to West Hartford Fire Station by 2.15, which is our designated 'Safe Place to Stand.'
- \*2.45pm lead car due to pass ahead of Cyclists
- \*3.00pm children leave West Hartford to return to Eastlea on foot
- \*3.45pm –pupils back at school [to walk/cycle home; be collected – see below]



As this is a visit out of school which takes place very early in the term, we are requesting specific permission in order to take your child out of school to take part in this event. We need the attached reply slip returned to school by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September please!
