Reading awards

The vast majority of our pupils have been eagerly reading at home as part of our circus reading challenge and getting you to sign their reading records each week. I am delighted to say that **174 children have now achieved their Bronze award** and next week we will be presenting the first of our **silver awards**!!

Punctuality and attendance

We are continuing with our successful focus on improving attendance and punctuality. At the half way point of the school year we only have 2 pupils currently at Eastlea who have attendance below 85% (classified as persistent absentees). This means we have once again maintained the very low figure which has been our target for this year which is extremely positive!!

- Year 4 won our overall award for the **best attendance** for the first half of the spring term with an average of 97.83%, narrowly beating Year 6 who managed 97.38% attendance. This is the second time that Year 4 have won the certificate this year well done!
- Year 6 were awarded with a certificate for the best punctuality during the half term they had only 5 'lates' recorded in the first half of the spring term; the next closest was Year 2 who had 9 congratulations to Year 6 who have been aiming for this award for some time!!

Payments for residential visits in Year 5 and Year 6 – AN IMPORTANT REMINDER!!

If you have a child in Year 5 or Year 6 who is going to be taking part in the Hawkhirst or York visits please remember that the deadline has now passed for the next instalments of the money to be paid.
