School Meals

We have made some amendments to our school lunch menus for the coming weeks - copies are attached to this newsletter for reference. Week 1 of the new menu will start next week on Monday 13th June.

As you will be aware the cost of food has been rising sharply. We have worked hard to maintain the price of meals at their current rates for a long time now, and they will remain as they are for the rest of the school year. However, I need to give you advanced warning that as from September the daily cost for a meal will be rising to £2.50 for Year 3 – Year 6 for those who pay and to £2.20 for Nursery pupils.

Nut allergy update

Can we also remind everyone that due to allergies experienced by some children at Eastlea we need to reinforce our **NO NUTS in school policy**. Children who bring in food for packed lunches / snacks need to ensure that these are nut free at all times to protect the health and safety of everyone in school (this

Parking update

We had a range of issues with parking again before the half term break with some difficulties experienced by both parents coming to school and also local residents. Some of these have been easily addressed, but there remain concerns that if the narrow estate roads surrounding the school are blocked with cars parked inconsiderately then if there was need for quick access by an emergency vehicle we could have a real problem on our hands. I know council representatives have again been contacted about this and I believe they are considering if any other measures can be put in place.

In the meantime can we again ask that you make use of the park and stride facility offered from the Church of the Nazarene which is a really good option for those who have to bring their cars to school each day. It is just a few minutes walk from the Church carpark to Eastlea and will help to avoid some of the worst congestion. Feedback from families who use it is universally positive so it might be worth a try. Parking 'permits' can be collected from school at any time. Thank you.
