We are delighted to announce our next Golden Day which will take place on **Thursday 29th March 2018** and have been able to book two activities which were high on the wish list for children in all classes!

Thursday 29th March will be a **non-uniform day** for all pupils and depending on their year group they will be involved in one of two visits:

- Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 pupils morning visit to 'Bounce' in Blyth followed by lunch at Eastlea and afternoon activities in school
- Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 pupils full day visit to 'Wet 'n Wild' (packed lunch will be required)

As before there will be **NO CHARGE FOR THESE VISITS.** The children are not required to pay a '£1 fine' for coming to school in non-uniform, and the transport costs and entrance fees to Bounce or Wet 'n Wild **are being provided free for all children who earn the right to take part in 'Golden Day'.** All that will be required is the usual lunch cost of £2.30 for Year 3 pupils if applicable (or £2.00 for 30 hour Nursery pupils) and a packed lunch for pupils in Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6.

There will be no other public access to Wet 'n Wild during our session which will be fully supervised by trained lifeguards as well as Eastlea staff.

As with the previous 'Golden Days', attendance is dependent on each child following the Eastlea rules in school and at lunchtimes. We are hoping to include all children; however, for those who are struggling to follow the rules, we will contact parents to discuss how we will support your child to get them 'back on track' in terms of behaviour.
