What a year this has been!! As I said to the Year 6 parents/families earlier this week I think I can safely say that NONE of us have ever been part of a school year like it and because, as a staff, we have been involved in the ever changing situation each step of the way I think it will only be in the next few days and weeks that we can stop and reflect on what a HUGE undertaking we have been involved with to keep Eastlea running as best we can in such trying circumstances. What I am clear about is that this would not have been possible without **ALL** the elements of the 'Eastlea Team' working together... staff, governors, parents/carers/family members and pupils. **THANK YOU for the part you have all played in this!** 

## September reopening information

- Eastlea will be closed for the summer holidays and will reopen for <u>all</u> pupils on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup>
  September 2020. This follows the late August bank holiday on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> August and a staff training day on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> September.
- I will keep my eye on any changes to government guidelines and procedures, but unless something changes locally/nationally, we plan to have ALL children back in ALL classes for FIVE days a week from September.
- All Nursery pupils will be in school for the morning sessions from September (8.45 11.45am). Those who are eligible for 30 hours will stay all day. [N.B. Some of our youngest new Nursery pupils will not return until Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September but this has already been outlined to those involved].
- Reception pupils will have a slightly 'phased' start to ensure staff can best support their transition. Mrs Atkinson will be in touch to explain precise details, but for the majority in the class this will involve attending for the mornings on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup>/Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September then morning and lunch on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> before full days from Monday 7<sup>th</sup>.
- The staggered starting/finishing times and use of designated access gates/doors has worked exceptionally well and our aim will be to continue with 'similar' arrangements – as this will ease any potential congestion when we have the full classes attending each day. Confirmation of these arrangements will be shared towards the end of the holiday and also outlined when you attend the reopen day on 27<sup>th</sup> August – see below!
- On Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> August we will be holding an 'Eastlea Re-open Day' between 10am 2pm. This will give pupils/parents a chance to come to school to see their new classroom and meet their new teacher...something we feel is very important. We will inform you of more details about how this will be organised later in the holidays but please put the date in your diary! This will also be an opportunity to collect/order any further items of school uniform as we hope to have had another delivery by then (fingers crossed).
- For our Year 6 pupils and their families thanks for the huge numbers who attended our socially distant Leavers' Celebration event on Tuesday. We wish you well as you begin your secondary school journey and remember to look out for information over the summer from your new schools about start dates and arrangements! GOOD LUCK!
