



'Around the World' Golden Day!



Today we started the countdown to our next 'Golden Day' which will take place on **Friday 28th May 2021.** We know that the ongoing national Covid restrictions for 'holidays' to many destinations are still in place – so for our Golden Day we thought we would do some 'virtual travel'...and go around the world (in school!!)

Each class will take a slightly different approach depending on which countries they decide to 'visit' but there are some whole school activities as well which will involve most of the children. Here are some of the things we have planned:

1. **Friday 28th May will be a non-uniform day for all children**. We hope the 'around the world' theme will provide plenty of scope for possible outfits – perhaps casual clothes as a tourist/holidaymaker heading abroad, or the colours of a flag from another country...or something specific linked to a class theme:

[e.g. Reception and Year 2 will be aiming to 'visit' as many different countries as they can during the day, Nursery and Year 1 will be 'flying across to' the USA - red, white and blue/stars and stripes/Disney, Year 3 will be 'visiting' Italy - green, white and red; Year 5 will be 'travelling' between Italy and Greece (blue and white); Brazil will be the 'destination' for Year 6, while Year 4 are enjoying a Mediterranean cruise]



2. From Reception upwards each class will have a **Spanish** dance workshop to learn the **Flamenco**...led by Mme Taylor.

3. For those in school all day, our lunch will have an Italian theme – with pizzas being delivered from Sambucas for all the children – we will need a menu choice from returned (see below) – and Neapolitan ice-cream provided by the Hungry Hatch!

As always for our Golden Days there will be **NO CHARGE FOR THIS DAY** – the costs of the activities, the dance workshop, any class refreshments and the Sambucas lunch will be **provided free for all children** who earn the right to take part.

As with all our 'Golden Days', attendance is dependent on each child following the Eastlea rules in school and at lunchtimes. We are hoping to include all children; however, for those who are struggling to follow the rules, we will be in contact with parents to discuss ways to support children to get them 'back on track' in terms of behaviour.
