

Eastlea Primary School KS2 SATs results 2017

This year was the second time that the new format of SATs were taken by Year 6 based on the revised national curriculum which is significantly more challenging than the previous curriculum.

Following a 'data dip' nationally in 2016 the results of pupils at Eastlea were once again back on track in terms of comparison to national averages as well as pupil progress. We were delighted with the outcomes for our pupils which reflect the hard work they have shown and the dedication of the staff.

Please see the table below to see how Eastlea performed including how we compared with other schools nationally. *A scaled score of 100 is the 'expected standard' for the end of the key stage – anything above this figure is <u>above the expected standard</u> – something the Eastlea pupils achieved in all subjects!
