



Dear Parents/Carers,

### **Y6 SATs and Y2 Secret Agent Training**

Our Year 6 and Year 2 children have worked incredibly hard and should be very proud of themselves. By the end of today, they will have all completed their national assessments in reading, maths arithmetic/reasoning plus 'SPaG' as well for Y6. They have all worked to the best of their ability – well done to them all!

They have now had 2 visits to the garden and last week 3 of the team members from Alnwick came to work with the children (and family members) here at Eastlea.
