





We are delighted to announce our final Golden Day of this school year which will take place on **Thursday 19**th **July 2018**. When we review the options with the children one of the most popular Golden Days is a visit to the beach and as it is a while since we have done this...we have decided to arrange this again, so a whole school visit to Blyth beach has been planned for our last Golden Day of the year!

As before there will be **NO CHARGE FOR THIS VISIT.** We will travel to Blyth Beach by coach and the transport costs will be funded. Each class teacher has organised for the children to be involved in a range of activities at the beach during the day – including playing on the beach, building sand castles, a beach treasure hunt, art and craft activities, sports and games, access to the play park and of course we have booked life guards for the day to ensure closely supervised paddling in the sea!! Weather permitting we will also provide the children with an ice lolly during the day.

As you might expect, there are several things which you need to be aware of to make sure that your child is well prepared for their day on the beach and has everything they need with them to ensure a fun filled and safe day.

Details of the visit	ALL Children will need
 Date – Thursday 19th July 2018 	• To come to school wearing appropriate clothing for the beach including suitable footwear (no school uniform is required on the day and no jewellery please)
Leave Eastlea – 9am	 A hat – this is essential!! A packed lunch to eat at the beach with a drink
Nursery and Reception:	A named plastic bottle of water
Arrive back at Eastlea – by 1.20pm – please note the longer session for morning Nursery children [15 hour Nursery pupils can	 Sun cream applied before they come to school – if you do not want us to reapply cream during the day then you must inform your child's class teacher, otherwise we will reapply sun cream on the day – the children can bring their own or we will use school cream
be collected from school at 1.20pm]	 Suitable waterproof, jumper, tracksuit bottoms/leggings etc (if the weather changes it can be cool and windy at the beachand could of course be wet!)
• Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6: Arrive back at Eastlea – by 3.15pm	 A bucket and spade (only if they have one!) A small towel and a change of t-shirt/swim shorts etc for when they paddle in the sea

As with the previous 'Golden Days', attendance is dependent on each child following the Eastlea rules both in school and at lunchtimes. We are hoping to include all children; however, for those who are struggling to follow the rules, we will contact parents to discuss how we will support your child to get them 'back on track' in terms of behaviour.
