Druridge Bay Golden Day!



We are delighted to announce our next Golden Day which will take place on **Thursday 24th March 2016**. We have been able to book a day of varied activities for everyone from Year 1 to Year 6 at **Druridge Bay Country Park in Northumberland**.

We know that outdoor activities are always popular with the children and we have been fortunate enough to secure a booking at Druridge Bay for the whole day as a treat for those who have been trying hard with their behaviour during this half term!

As before there will be **NO CHARGE FOR THIS VISIT.** We will travel by coach to Druridge Bay and the transport costs, equipment hire and the cost of providing qualified coaches/experts for some of the activities are being provided free for all children who are taking part in 'Golden Day'.

The activities we have arranged on the day are understandably quite varied in order to best meet the needs of the different age groups – ranging from orienteering, scavenger/treasure hunts, kitemaking and flying (weather permitting!!) and kayaking/open canoeing for the older children. All of the sessions are organised and supervised by Eastlea staff except for the kayaking which will of course be led by qualified coaches from the centre.

We have access to an indoor area which we can use during the day and at lunchtime to eat our packed lunches if required. The coaches will also be on standby to return us to school early in the case of poor weather.

The day will be a non-uniform day for everyone. For parents/carers of pupils in Y5/Y6 it is important that the children wear/bring the correct items especially in terms of the kayaking/open canoeing activity – so please take special note of the details below *and return the attached consent form (Y5/Y6 only)*:

We are hoping to include all children; however, for those who are struggling to follow the rules, we will contact parents to discuss how we will support your child to get them 'back on track' in terms of behaviour.
