



## Eastlea Primary : Pupil premium – planned expenditure 2018-19

Budget income for pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium (75) is based on the latest figures available for the school year 2018-19.

Pupil premium provides £1300 per eligible pupil. This means a total of **£97,500**.

Funding to subsidise transport costs for class visits to allow first hand experiences of targeted curriculum areas	£2400

Expert MFL input provided for Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 with weekly half day of support from external provider	£2000 (approx.)
Rewards and incentives to promote attendance, Maths and English to embed the focus areas of the school improvement plan	£500
Additional funding to supplement supply cover costs as part of the TRG maths mastery workgroup and purchase maths resources to further embed the maths mastery approach	£1500
Read Write Inc online subscription for access to phonics resources plus teacher reference books, additional workbooks/reading books across school	£500
Additional funding to provide SEND SLA input from providers for behaviour, speech and language, ASD and educational psychologist	£8200 (approx.)
Enrichment activities for pupils – e.g. theatre group visits, writing/maths workshops etc	£1000 (approx.)
