EASTLEA BREAKFAST CLUB

Our Breakfast Club is proving very popular and we have larger groups attending the sessions each morning. This is great news for the children as it means that there are always plenty of friends for them to share their breakfast with and talk to in the mornings, but it can mean that the noise levels rise in the library and this is something which we wish to address.

This week, we have spoken to most of the children who attend Breakfast Club to 'go over the rules' of what we expect and reinforce the behaviour we wish to see in the mornings. A copy of this is outlined below.

We have also explained to the children that if they are finding it tricky to follow the rules and don't seem to be responding to adult reminders then they may be asked to leave the library area and go and sit separately in their classroom with a teacher. You will be informed if this happens. Repeated instances of this would lead to your child being asked to not attend Breakfast Club in the short term.

I know we can rely on your support to encourage your children to behave quietly and responsibly in Breakfast Club – just like they do for the rest of their school day at Eastlea.
