

Eastlea Year 4 COVID update

Dear Parents / Carers,

As outlined in our Covid protocols, I wanted to let you know that at lunchtime today we had a POSITIVE Covid case identified within the Year 4 class. The only 'symptom' identified was feeling cold/shivery and the lateral flow test was taken as a precaution.

National guidance states that:

- close contacts of COVID-19 cases including children aged 5+ should take an LFD test every day for seven days and, if negative, can continue to attend school as normal.
- If symptoms emerge, however mild, then a PCR test should still be sought.

We therefore ask you to be vigilant and alert to <u>any</u> symptoms of illness whatsoever. As the rest of Year 4 are close contacts of this case we would also **strongly recommend that your child takes a Lateral Flow test before they come to school each morning for the remaining days this week and Monday/Tuesday next week.**

If there is a problem with accessing lateral flow tests then please alert Mrs Thirlwell via Seesaw or ring school to inform me and we will do what we can to help.
