The Summer Reading Challenge has always been an important event for our children to take part in over the summer holidays. Many of our families in school have joined in with this event over many years and this has encouraged their children to continue to read over the summer which is so important and continues to encourage the love of reading.

There are two ways you can take part in the Summer Reading Challenge:

You can join the challenge at your local library and take part in person. The library will give you a special collector folder, stickers and other special incentives, and help you find books to read for your challenge.

Alternatively, take part in the challenge online at **summerreadingchallenge.org.uk**

and sign up. Set a reading goal and log your books on your profile. When you reach your goal you will unlock a virtual badge and certificate.

The **Story Garden** Reading Challenge is coming to a library near you this summer. The challenge runs from Saturday 12th July until mid September 2025.

Cramlington library starts the challenge on Saturday 12th July 2025.

Children are being asked to read 6 books from the library over the course of the challenge and after reading 6 books they earn a certificate and a medal which they will collect from the library at a celebration event in September.

Children can read any library book of their choice; fiction, non-fiction, picture books or books they share with parents and carers – they all count!

The Summer Reading Challenge is delivered by libraries and produced by The Reading Agency. It is open to all children, **free of charge**.
