

Early Years Teddy Bears' Pieniel




We are delighted to announce our next 'Golden Day' which will take place on **Thursday 24th March 2016.** We are planning a 'Golden Day treat' for children in Nursery and Reception which involves an activity morning in school including a visit to the local Northburn Park. *Children in other classes will be bringing home a separate letter about their Golden Day.*

It will be a non-uniform day for them and as they will be outside they need to have suitable footwear and a waterproof coat.
