



Year 6 End of Term Information

Dear Parents/Carers,

The summer is getting closer, and this is a busy time for our Year 6 in school, as they prepare for transition to the JLV and to say goodbye to Eastlea. Although government restrictions are still in place, we feel it is important that the children have the chance to finish their primary schooling properly and therefore we have planned a number of events for them.

Firstly, we are really pleased to inform you that we have been invited to a **transition morning at the JLV on Tuesday 29th June**. We think that it is important that the children have the opportunity to walk the route to the High School, so we will need them to be at Eastlea for **8am** to allow time for us to do this. The children will walk up to the JLV with the Year 6 staff who will be joining them for their visit. Our session at the JLV will finish at 10.30am so we will have plenty of time to walk back to Eastlea in time for lunch. The children will need to be in full school uniform for this day so that they make a smart and positive first impression on their new teachers. They will also need their school bag with them as there will be resources which they will take away with them at the end of the morning.

Next of course, the majority are very much looking forward to their two residential activity days at the beginning of July! Final details for this will be sent out a little nearer the time and if anyone still has money to pay then please can we have this asap. Thank you!



In the last week of term, we are also hoping to celebrate their time at Eastlea with a **socially distanced Leavers' celebration** in the school playground on **Tuesday 13th July from 3.30pm**. The children are putting a lot of work into preparing for this event and will stay back after school on the day ready to welcome you as their guests – a separate invitation for parents/families will follow.

And finally, as well as several school events for the end of term we are also planning a **Year 6 Leavers' meal at Sambucas** after school on **Thursday 15th July** (which is their last Eastlea Golden Day!) The children will have the chance to go home after Golden Day (we propose to allow them all to leave at 3pm that afternoon) so that they can get changed and return to school for 4.00pm where we will walk them up to Sambucas. There is nothing to pay for this as school will be funding their meal as a thank you for being a fantastic year group! We do hope that everyone can attend and there will be a separate letter about this nearer the time to make their menu choice and indicate their arrangements for getting home – after the meal **the children will need to be collected from Sambucas at 6pm**.

We do hope that the last few weeks of their time at Eastlea are going to be good ones and provide them with many more memories which they will take from their time with us,
