This is a national event and we will be splitting any funds raised between the NSPCC charity and school funds for Maths.


So, for Number Day 2018 - Friday 2nd February 2018 this is what we plan to do...



• A non-uniform day with a 'maths' theme – the children can come dressed wearing anything they like to do with any aspect of maths – this could be something with a number or a shape on, or something with a pattern perhaps?

The 'fine' for wearing non-uniform will be a minimum donation of £1 which will go towards the national NSPCC/school fundraising campaign. This will be paid in to the class teacher in the morning on the day.

• During the day all the children will be taking part in some mathematical activities – to develop their numerical, problem solving and reasoning skills and to apply their 'Ninja' times tables knowledge.





We also aim to have some class/rocket group competitions and challenges on the day and for this your child needs to bring in some different coins (as well as their £1 fine), e.g. how many 20p coins can we collect to fill smartles tubes...and which rocket group will have the most overall? So, start collecting your 20p coins or bring in other coins and we will exchange them for '20 pences' on the day – all good examples of practical maths in action!

Thanks in advance for your support with this event! I'm sure that as always at Eastlea we will have a fun filled fundraising Number Day whilst at the same time raising money for a very worthwhile cause.
