Dear Parents / Carers,

On Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June we have arranged a '**Wear RED**' charity fundraising day for two local charities which approached us for support just before half term:

- **Hearts in our Hands** is a campaign started by local residents to raise money to put Life Saving **Defibrillators** on all the housing estates in Cramlington. *[After a donation from the Duke of Northumberland the first defibrillator has been installed at Pronto Pizza, High Pit. The next defibrillators are due to be installed on St Nicholas Manor and Shankhouse Club.]*
- **Bright Red** is a small local charity with an office based in Cramlington supporting people in the North East with **blood disorders such as leukaemia, myeloma, lymphoma.**

We have decided to support both local charities and will ask that the children come to school on Friday wearing something **RED**...this could be anything from just one item of clothing to a fully red outfit! As a '**fine**' for this non-uniform day we are asking for a donation of **at least £1** to go into our red charity bucket. All the money raised will be split equally between the two charities.



As with our other fundraising days, I hope the children will enjoy their 'Wear something red' day knowing that they are supporting two very worthwhile local charities. Thank you in advance for your support!
